Description of Corporate Citizen Award

This award recognizes **owners, board members, employees, or volunteers** in a corporation or business who actively engage in **community and civic initiatives** that align with the mission of the NAACP.

Nomination Guidelines

The nominee must meet one or more of the following guidelines:

- Be currently employed or serve as a **board member, volunteer, or owner** of a corporation or business that provides **community services** or resources.
- Demonstrate a **commitment** to partner with or provide resources to the community in areas like **economic sustainability, education, health, public safety/criminal justice, voting rights, environmental issues, or youth engagement**.
- Contribute or donate **in-kind services** as part of their commitment to community participation.
- Actively participate in **internship programs, work-study opportunities, or volunteer mentorship programs** for individuals looking to grow and develop.
- Demonstrate **engagement** with the community by using their **knowledge, skills, and talent** as a mentor, volunteer, or leader in creating meaningful change.
